

PATRIOTIC PINWHEEL

Create this colorful July 4th craft.

What you need:

- Decorated card stock square (5" x 5")
- Scissors
- Hole punch
- 2 one-inch circles of card stock
- Glue
- Pipe cleaner (3 inches)
- Drinking straw



What you do:

1. Fold the square corner to corner to form an X. Unfold.
2. To make spokes, cut the four creases until an inch from the center.
3. Punch a hole in the middle of the square, near the tips of each spoke, and in the middle of each circle.
4. Fold each spoke toward the center, lining up the holes. Glue in place.
5. Wrap one end of the pipe cleaner around the top of the straw. Thread a circle, the pinwheel, and the remaining circle onto the pipe cleaner.
6. Roll the pipe cleaner end into a ball. Then spin!

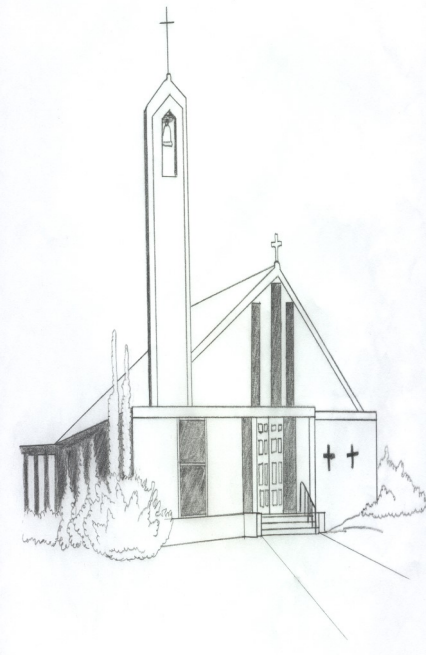

Did you know?

- **The Continental Congress** voted for independence on July 2, 1776, but we celebrate our nation's independence on July 4th because that's when the Declaration of Independence was formally adopted.
- **President Zachary Taylor** tragically died in 1850 after eating spoiled fruit follow 4th of July speeches. Vice President Millard Fillmore then assumed the presidency.
- **Massachusetts** became the first state to declare the 4th of July an official state holiday in 1781, although it wasn't declared a Federal holiday until 1941.
- **The Liberty Bell** in Philadelphia is tapped 13 times every July 4th in honor of the the original 13 colonies. Its inscription reads, "Proclaim Liberty Throughout All the Land Unto All the Inhabitants Therof"
- **Both John Adams and Thomas Jefferson**, signers of the Declaration of Independence, died on July 4, 1826, coincidentally on it's 50th anniversary.
