Pentecost rejects a tepid Christian life. The Lord Jesus said to the apostles, "I have come to cast a fire on the earth" (Luke 12:49). This is a feast about fire, a transformative, refining, purifying fire that the Lord wants to kindle in us.



In the Gospel today is the great commission: The Lord said, "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you."

The Spirit of the Lord wants to fill the earth, in the fiery transformation of every Christian going forth to bring warmth and light to a cold, dark world.

This is how the Lord casts fire upon the earth. This is how the Spirit of the Lord fills the orb of the earth — in the lives of saints (and in your life)! The Spirit of the Lord is going to fill the orb of the earth but only through us.
