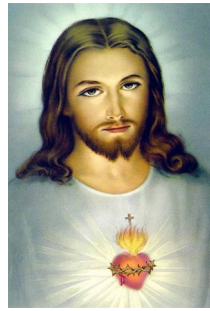


12 Promises of the Sacred Heart of Jesus

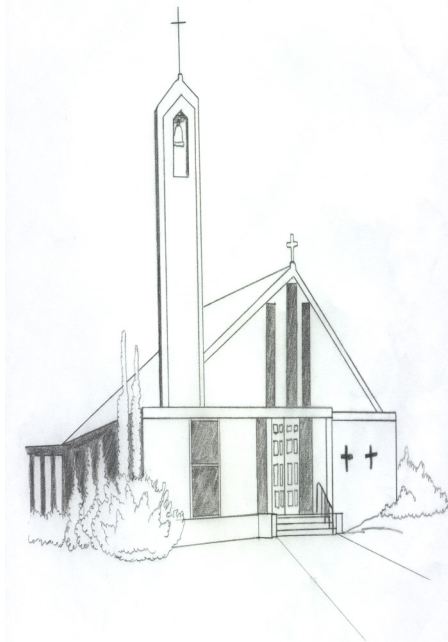
