From the Pastor's desk August 23-24

I have heard many times, from our separated brothers, that faithful Catholics do not read Bible or have little knowledge of Jesus teaching. Is it true? Of course not.

With almost 1.406 billion Catholics who are in 3,300 Ecclesiastical areas, including 2,300 dioceses, and in USA 196 dioceses who pray daily with around 407,000 priests in 223,000 parishes, we worship God in each Catholic Mass about 155 times every minute. Would you invite your friend to worship Our heavenly Father together?

All these testify that we Catholics glorify God much more than any denomination.

Last Monday we heard from Jesus; that to attain the Perfection of Eternal Life, we should keep God's commandments."

On Tuesday Jesus reminded us that "it is easier for a camel to pass through the eye of a needle than for one who is rich to enter the Kingdom of God."

On Wednesday He teaches us that we should imitate God's generosity in some way.

On Thursday we heard Jesus' invitation to the King's Feast which reminds us of the Last Supper. He is the royal bridegroom. Do we have any excuse to reject His invitation?

On Friday the Liturgy reminded us that we should honor the Queenship of the Blessed Virgin Mary. She is the model disciple who heard God's word and accepted it.

On Saturday when we want to enjoy the weekend, we should turn our eyes on Our Humble Redeemer. Are we convinced that "humility is truth" that directs our steps to the narrow gate?
