From the Pastor's Desk and Announcements
September 13 & 14, 2025

Everyone should know in this parish that we like to improve our participation in the Eucharist. The Eucharist is an action of thanksgiving to God. For this reason we like to train two (2) groups, Lectors and Extra Ordinary Ministers of the Holy Eucharist. Last Wednesday, we had our first training session with the Lectors, so we will continue to instruct all members who signed up from the list. When we complete the training, we will have at least 3 Lectors for each Mass and they will be officially installed in this parish.

After the Lectors have installed, we will begin with the Extra Ordinary Ministers of the Holy Communion. After installation of the ministers we parishioners will offer the opportunity to receive the Body and Blood of Christ at the same moment.

Participating in that way, in the Eucharistic celebration will unite us in full communion that this is the anticipation in eternal Life.

We will be receiving a new chalice with paten that you can receive only directly from the priest. If you would like to receive in the hand, you can receive from an Extra Ordinary Minister of the Holy Communion.

I will also purchase a new chasuble with the Blessed Mother imprinted. At this time we do not have any nice chasubles that symbolize the Mother of God. If you would like to donate for the new chasuble, please place your donation in an envelope earmarked "Chasuble". In next weekend's bulletin we will make a note of the cost of the chasuble.
